

## Cafeteria Services

The Union Grove ISD serves meals each school day. Children may buy lunch in grades PK – 6 for \$2.50, and grades 7 – 12 for \$2.60. Breakfast will be served at \$1.25 for grades PK – 6, and \$1.50 for grades 7 – 12. All meals may be prepaid. Children also may get meals free or at a reduced price if qualified. An application for Free / Reduced Price Meals is included in your enrollment packet, along with the income guidelines that will be used to determine qualification. For further information concerning Free / Reduced Price Meals, please contact Cynthia Vance at the Food Service Office at (903)844-3921.

In accord with School Board action, there will be a limit of \$10.00 maximum charges in the cafeteria for meals. If the student exceeds the \$10.00 limit, an alternate meal of a cheese sandwich, milk and fruit will be prepared for the student. The student may receive the alternate meal for a maximum of two weeks. After that time the alternate meals will be stopped and the student will be responsible for paying for meals or bringing their lunch from home.
