- I. Mobile Asthma Doctor- Jodie Mayhan updated the committee about the mobile asthma Dr. from UT Health Center. The Dr. will be on our campuses March 30<sup>th</sup>. Parents of Elementary students will receive a letter. Students on the Secondary campus will be identified by the nurse's office and their parents will be notified. Parents will also be contacted by UT Health Center staff to set up appointments with the mobile Dr. These appointments are no cost to the district or families.
- II. Female Self Defense Class- School Resource Officer Sherri Hunter presented 2 possible programs to the committee for female self defense classes. Stay Safe 360 was the first. This curriculum can be used to train both men and women to be more aware of their surroundings while at college. The second class, RAD, is a 9 hr. course that includes teaching situational awareness as well as self defense tactics and techniques. The SHAC committee, along with Officer Hunter will work to find a date in the late spring to offer both of these courses to our graduating senior girls and our female faculty.
