

Elementary Dress Code 2023-2024

- Hair should be neatly groomed and combed and needs to be out of the student's face. No mohawks or extreme hairstyles that distract from the learning environment (administrator discretion).
- Sleeveless shirts must be at least three fingers wide at the shoulder and may not show undergarments.
- All shirts must be long enough to cover the waistband.
- Holes in jeans must be below fingertip length when standing.
- Leggings are acceptable if the shirt or dress is long enough to completely cover the buttocks (without pulling the shirt down).
- Shorts must be long enough so that fingertips can't touch skin when the student stands and puts their hands down by their sides.
- No sunglasses (unless doctor note is provided)
- No pajamas, slippers or blankets.
- No hats, caps, toboggans, or hoodies inside any school building.
- Nothing will be allowed that advertises or refers to the following: sex, drugs, tobacco, alcohol, profanity, gambling, violence, questionable messages (as determined by administration)
- Nothing with names or symbols that represent secret societies or gangs as described in TEC 37.121
- Oversized coats/jackets are not permitted
- Face coverings are not permitted unless medically necessary.

*Any dress or grooming, that in the administrators judgment may interfere with the normal school operation is prohibited.
